During the Interstate 10 Improvement Project, the Arizona Department of Transportation has made a strong commitment to keeping motorists informed about progress and restrictions during this complex, comprehensive project. Because I-10 through metro Phoenix and Tucson are among the busiest sections of freeway in the nation, ongoing expansion projects will provide welcome relief for drivers and motor carriers. ADOT is taking extraordinary efforts statewide to reduce congestion, encourage safety in work zones and ease the impact of construction on motorists.

Current Project Overview

Construction within the median of I-10 from east of Sarival Avenue (MP 125.73) to Loop 101/Agua Fria Freeway (MP 133.85) includes adding one general purpose and one HOV lane in each direction.

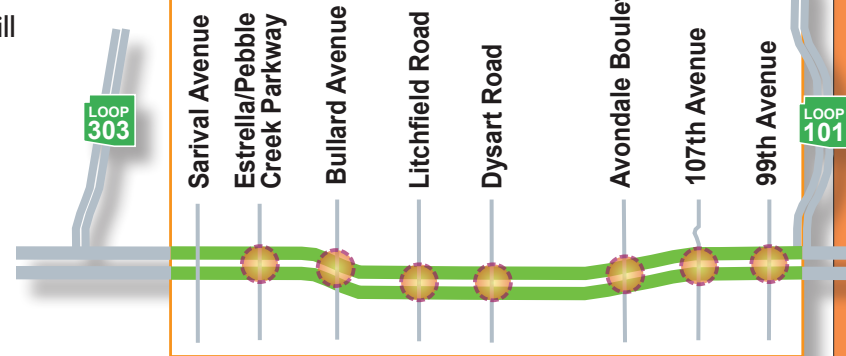

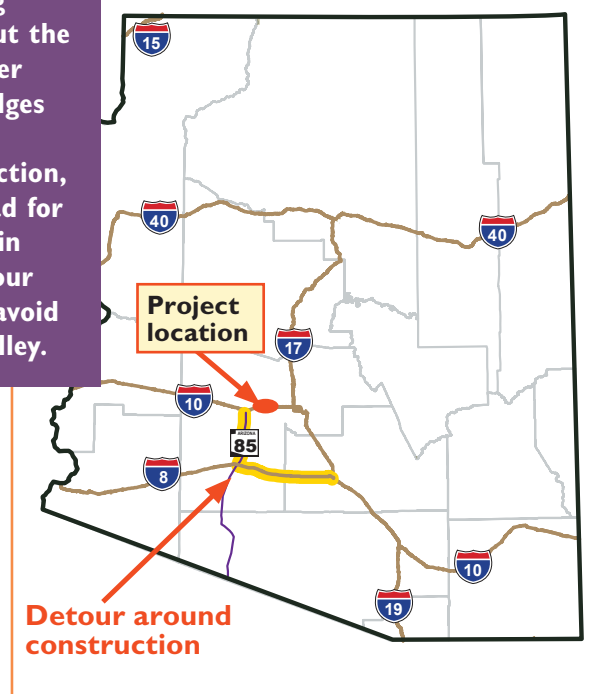

I-10 median widening



I-10 will remain open during peak travel times throughout the project, but crossroads under each of the interchange bridges will be closed or restricted periodically. During construction, it is important to plan ahead for restrictions and slow down in the work zone. Use the detour route highlighted below to avoid construction in the West Valley.
